You can choose (if you wish) to **increase your giving annually by inflation.** This is so helpful in protecting our church income in these difficult times.


The PGS helps us to help our Treasurer and finance team do the jobs we have asked them to do on our behalf.

What is Parish Giving Scheme?

The Parish Giving Scheme (PGS) is an effective and trusted way of giving to Holy Trinity. It is used by two thirds of dioceses and 4,000 givers in 90% of Liverpool parishes.

The PGS is a charity; it's not for profit. It is free; for Holy Trinity and for our givers.

Using Direct Debits, the PGS is safe, secure, and simple; and you stay in control, always.

The PGS helps all of us to be faithful and regular in our giving, growing in generosity and gratitude to God.

The PGS lightens the administrative load for all who look after the finances of our church, claiming our Gift Aid and helping with bank reconciliation, cash flow and planning.

"Please join me in using the Parish Giving Scheme to support our church. When money comes through the PGS, rather than by standing order or envelope, the Gift Aid is claimed automatically, and I can electronically upload our giving to our finance system. How does it work?

First, you join the PGS in one of the three easy ways described in this leaflet. Then your gift is given by Direct Debit monthly, quarterly or annually, as you choose.

Of course, you can also Gift Aid your giving, if you are able to do so. Gifts can be made by couples; whoever pays sufficient tax to cover the gift signs the Gift Aid signature box.

Leaving your account on the first of the month PGS helps us offer our first fruits to God. (Dt 26:1-4) and makes giving easy and efficient.



Why should I join?

Planned, faithful, regular giving is essential to Holy Trinity, never more so than now. Thank you for your support, your generosity.

We appreciate that many like to give by envelope (or by the offertory plate) and have done so for many years. It can feel strange to change. Sadly, the pandemic demonstrated the vulnerability of this valued way of giving.

The PGS is for everyone with a bank account. It is not dependent on age, income, employment or tax status. It's simply the most effective and helpful way for us to give to, support and resource our church.

The PGS also blesses us. As Christians we receive with open hands the overflowing generosity of God in Jesus. Our giving is our grateful response as disciples to a generous God. The PGS enables our giving, the first fruits of all that God has entrusted to us.

If you currently give by weekly envelope, or by the open plate, you can easily make the switch. You will see the benefit for you and for Holy Trinity and those who oversee our finances will be blessed by your decision.

You will be enriched in every way for your great generosity, which will produce thanksgiving to God through us.
